<u>Applications for Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) Internship Scheme at Northern Regional</u> Laboratory, Mohali

Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) is the National Standard Body of India established under the BIS Act, 2016 for the harmonious development of the activities of standardization, marking and quality certification of goods and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. BIS works under the aegis of the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Government of India with its head office situated at Manak Bhawan, 9, Bahadur Shah Zafar, New Delhi – 110002 with various regional offices, branch offices and laboratories situated across India.

- 2. BIS, Northern Regional Laboratory (NRL), Mohali, seeks to engage students (who are Masters Degree / Graduate Degree / Diploma holder or pursuing) as "Interns", who would be given exposure to the laboratory activity of BIS. The Interns would also be required to carry out regular testing of the various products received by BIS Laboratories under different BIS conformity assessment schemes.
- 3. NRL, Mohali invites applications for interns as per BIS Scheme (Copy attached: Appendix A, B & C; Annex. I, II & III., Proforma of Application) from eligible candidates willing to apply as per the terms and conditions for Interns.

Eligibility:

- (i) Internship Scheme can be availed by students enrolled in University in any of the disciplines given under **Appendix A**: (a) Under graduation (having completed studies at least 4 Semesters) (b) Post-Graduation (having completed studies at least 2 Semesters) (c) Post Graduate Diploma (d) Research Scholars. (e) Under Diploma Course.
- (ii) Degree/Diploma holders who have completed their studies within the last 180 days are also eligible for internship. (For considering the eligibility of the applicant, the last date of the term of the university/institution of the applicant and the date of submission of internship application by the applicant will be taken for calculation of 180 days)
- (iii) Students pursuing Undergraduate/Post Graduate/Post Graduate Diploma Courses shall have a good academic record and with minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 7.5 out of 10 as on the last semester, whose result has been declared.
- (iv) Research Scholars, shall have a good academic record and with minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average of 7.5 out of 10 in their Post-Graduation.
- (v) Students/Research Scholars shall be Indian Nationals.

<u>Duration:</u> The Internship Scheme would be available throughout the year based on the requirements of BIS and the timelines for Internship in the selected Institutions. The duration of Internship shall be for minimum one months to maximum upto six months.

<u>Stipend</u>: The Interns pursuing Bachelor's degree in Science/ Diploma Courses will be provided stipend of Rs. 15,000/- per month and the interns pursuing Bachelor's in Technology or Master's degree or higher will be provided a stipend of Rs. 20,000/- per month. The stipend will be calculated on pro-rata basis for each completed week.
