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### Academic Management System Inaugurated by DDG Education and World Bank TTL

he Academic Management System (AMS) developed under NAHEP Component2 was formally inaugurated on July 27, 2022 by Dr. R.C. Agrawal, DDG (Education), ICAR and National Director, NAHEP in presence of Dr. Bekzod Shamsiev, Senior Agriculture Economist and Task Team Leader, World Bank; Dr. A.K. Shukla, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, GBPUAT, Pantnagar; Dr. Anuradha Agrawal, National Coordinator, CAAST and Component-2, NAHEP; Dr. S.K. Kashyap, PI, IDP-NAHEP Pantnagar; Dr. Sudeep Marwaha, PI, NAHEP Component 2; Dr. Vinod Kumar, Controller of Examinations, GBPUAT, Pantnagar and Dr. S.K. Goel, AMS Coordinator, GBPUAT, Pantnagar. The AMS is a critical intervention to enhance the overall academic administration of agricultural universities.

The Academic Management System (AMS Version 2.0), a web-based application is developed under NAHEP Component 2 to administer a variety of academic activities all together at one platform. It is going to cater to the requirements of various users, including deans, registrars, heads, advisors, teachers, UG/PG/Ph.D. students, administrators and officials, to efficiently undertake their official tasks. It also includes multiple sub-modules viz., course management, student management, faculty management, e-learning, e-registration including fee submission. This system is being uniformly implemented across the agricultural universities of the country. At Pantnagar, the implementation has already successfully initiated.



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The review team closely reviewed all the units and facilities developed by the IDP-NAHEP Pantnagar. During the review, Dr. Ramasundaram said that IDP-NAHEP, Pantnagar has implemented all innovative programmes for student quality enhancement with utmost sincerity. As a result, the project has been more successfully recognized at the national level.

The World Bank Review Mission team also had an interaction with the student beneficiaries of the project. 

### 15 Hours Workshop on Microsoft Excel Organized by IDP-NAHEP, Pantnagar

he IDP-NAHEP, Pantnagar initiated an extensive Summer Activity Plan for the undergraduate students of Pantnagar University aiming to make them more competent in multidisciplinary aspects. As a part of this plan, the IDP-NAHEP, Pantnagar organized a 15 hours workshop on *Microsoft Excel Training: Core to Advance* from July 19, 2022 to July 29, 2022. The expert for the workshop was Mr. Yogesh Pandey, Trainer, Vista Academy, Dehradun. Mr. Pandey is an accomplished trainer with more than one and a half decade of training experience in Microsoft Office Services.

The 15 hours practical workshop initiated with the welcome address by Dr. S. K. Guru, Nodal Officer (Academic), IDP-NAHEP, Pantnagar where he stated the benefits and necessity of MS Excel and other related applications in one's professional life. The workshop was an eagerly awaited one by the University students, and the expert also invested best of his efforts in nurturing the students. The workshop was focussed mainly on getting to know the Microsoft Excel tool bar, shortcut keys, creating a



worksheet, working with charts, graphs, data and designs, basic to advance excel formulas, functions, and formatting. More than 65 students consistently and actively participated in this workshop with lots of curious questions. The workshop received enthusiastic feedback from the students as it was directly aligned with enhancing their skills in data interpretation.



### 15 Days Workshop Held on Mobile Application Development for Agriculture and Allied Sciences

he Academic Component of IDP-NAHEP organized a 15-days workshop on Mobile Application Development for Agriculture and Allied Sciences from July 25 to August 8, 2022. The workshop was held in virtual mode and the goal of the workshop was to hone students' technical abilities so that they can create mobile apps that meet the needs of agriculture and allied sciences. It was led by Ms. Sonam Pandey, Director, and Mr. Gaurav Pant, Consultant, ACTECAL Private Limited, Uttarakhand.

The expert Ms. Pandey primarily elaborated about the three stages to develop an application i.e. design, coding, and hosting as well as the best practices for naming variables. Mr. Pant continued to describe the App Lab, as an environment for programming where anyone can create simple apps by using blocks or text and share them instantly. Students also had hands-on learning experience with MIT App Inventor which is an integrated development environment (IDE) for web applications that enables programmers of any expertise

level to create apps for the Android and iOS operating systems. It is free and open-source software published under two licenses: the Creative Commons Attribution ShareAlike







3.0 Unported license and the Apache License 2.0 for the source code. Students were also acquainted with the knowledge of how the application programming interface is used to incorporate real-time weather information into apps.

The experts made sure that all of the participants were actively involved by giving them assignments and lots of questions and responses. A total of 40 people attended the workshop consistently and developed their own mobile apps as well. They expressed their thoughts, and highlighted the value of events like this in developing technical skills.

#### Making Foreign Language Learning Experience Interesting and Easier

he Language Lab Component of IDP-NAHEP, Pantnagar is one of the most cherished components having utmost impact on student skill development. More than 800 undergraduate students of Pantnagar University have been a part of foreign language classes which have been taught in an innovative manner. Apart from conducting regular classroom sessions, various language learning activities and exercises are conducted frequently so that the learning experience of students become interesting as well as easier. A Family Tree Poster Making Event using French Possessive adjectives was organized on July 6, 2022. The students of French Language classes participated in the event and created a family tree with their own family members' names and also wrote a letter to them in the French Language.

Editing photographs has become an essential part of photography and digital designing. The expert of the session was Mr. Rishabh Bametha, Photographer, IDP-NAHEP Pantnagar. The hands-on workshop started with the blessings and insights of Dr. S.K. Guru, Nodal Officer (Academic), IDP-NAHEP, Pantnagar where he shared his interest in photography and photo editing. He also shared some experiences about the necessity of photo editing. In the photo editing workshop, the expert discussed the process of installation, tool guide, shortcut keys, commands, marquee tools, lasso tools, brush tools, pen tools, eraser tools, path selection tool,

adjustments, exposure, etc. This enthusiastic workshop received participation from undergraduate students of the University and was attended by 60 participants. The event received active response from the participants who performed the real-time practices for the tools and functions being discussed during the sessions. Students also shared their feedback on how the workshop helped them in grooming their application handling techniques.

Till now, eight editions of the internship pathshala have been successfully completed with 104 beneficiaries from across the University. However, all eight editions were held in online mode. For the first time in its 9th edition, the NAHEP Internship Pathshala has been rolled out in offline mode.

Out of the applications of 67 undergraduate students from across the University, five students were selected. These were Ms. Shruti Pandey (B.Sc. Agriculture, third year), Mr. Akash Sharma (B.Sc.
