OFFICE ORDER


The Academic Council in its 375th meeting held on 13.08.2015 approved the following guidelines for the award of 1962 Batch of Agricultural Engineering Scholarship.

1. The scholarship shall be called 1962 Batch of Agricultural Engineering scholarship and will utilize about 60% interest earned from time to time on the investment of donations received from the graduates of 1962-66 batch of Agricultural Engineering. There shall be two merit scholarships for the students of Agricultural Engineering studying for bachelor degree as below.

Sl	Eligibility criteria	Scholarship Rs/month
1.	For a final year Indian student first position holder	Rs 2000/- per month
2.	For a third year Indian student first position holder	Rs 2000/- per month

2. The scholarships shall come into existence from the academic year 2015-16 and shall be payable from the date of registration every year.
3. The scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of merit only i.e. on the basis of CGPA. In case of tie, the awardees will be selected on the basis of higher marks in the last semester (6th and 4th semester for final and third year, respectively).
4. At the beginning of the first semester of final/third year applications on prescribed form shall be invited by the Dean, student Welfare. Based on the applications received, the following committee will finalize the names of Awardees.
- Dean, Student Welfare
 - Registrar
 - Dean, College of Technology
 - Coordinator Agril Engineering
5. Based on the approval of the Vice-Chancellor, the names are to be communicated by DSW to Dean College of Technology, who will make payment to the awardees.
6. For being eligible for the scholarship, candidate should not be on academic or conduct probation during his study period. Further, the candidate should not also be a recipient of another scholarship from the University or any other organization.
7. The scholarship to a student shall be for a maximum period of twelve months in a year and may terminate earlier on the day due to:
- (a) The student ceases to be on the roll of the University,
 - (b) The student completes his/her study as per the programme,
 - (c) The student opts for another scholarship or financial assistance,
8. In case the candidate on first position declines to avail the scholarship or in case of termination of scholarship for any reason to a student, the committee may consider other candidates based on merit from the date of termination to a maximum of total 12 months of scholarship in any academic year.
9. In all matters not provided in these regulations, the decision of the Vice-Chancellor of the university shall be final.

All concerned are to take necessary actions accordingly.
