Weather Summary/Alert:

Last seven days (11 to 17 February) observed no rainfall with maximum and minimum temperature varying between 21.0-26.0 and 4.4-8.6 oC, respectively. The weather was observed to be clear on most of the days during last week. The morning and evening relative humidity varied between 81-95% and 32-56%, respectively. The wind speed mostly ranged between 1.3-7.2 kmph blowing primarily from the west, west-north-west and south-south-west direction. The upcoming 5 day forecast shows very light rainfall of 5 mm with maximum and minimum temperature varying between 23.0-26.0oC and 7-9oC. The wind speed is expected to be 4-7 kmph from north-east, north-east-north, north and north-west-north. Light to moderate rain is likely to occur at few places on 20 February while dry weather is likely to prevail during rest of the period. A yellow warning regarding likely occurrence of thundercloud accompanied with lightening at isolated places has been given for 20 February.

General Advisory:

A regular update regarding weather forecast and agrometeorological advisory is available on the "Meghdoot App" while "Damini App" is also available to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini apps can be downloaded from Google Play Store (Android users) and App Center (iOS users). The NDVI composite shows good agricultural vigour in the region. The extended range forecast system shows deficient rainfall, normal maximum and below normal minimum temperature trend during 14 to 20 February.

SMS Advisory:

As per the IMD forecast, light to moderate rainfall is expected so irrigation application should be scheduled accordingly and any kind of spray application should be avoided under windy condition.

BARLEY	At flowering stage, irrigation should be applied to the crop and weed control practices should be followed in late sown crops. On regular monitoring for disease or pest occurrence in late sown crops, recommended practices should be followed.
SUGARCANE	To get good yield, the new sugarcane crop should be cut and irrigation application along with hoeing-weeding operations should be carried out in the autumn sugarcane crop.
