General Advisory:

In view of the severe spread of Corona (Covid-19), the farmers are advised to follow the guidelines given by the Government of India during agricultural operations. Harvesting of mature vegetable crops should be done.

SMS Advisory:

There is a forecast of no rain in the coming five days.

Crop Specific Advisory:

LENTIL	Weeding and hoeing should be done in the crop.
MUSTARD	In valley and low hills, light irrigation should be given at the time of grain filling in the timely sown crop.
WHEAT	In the Bhabar region, late sowing of the wheat crop should be completed.

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

Horticulture(Varieties)	Horticulture Specific Advisory
VEGETABLE PEA	In unirrigated mid hills where there is a less possibility of hail, sowing of Arkil variety of pea should be done.
FRENCH BEAN	In the irrigated valley, if the french bean (frsbean) is sown two months prior then plucking of pods should be done.

Live Stock Specific Advisory:

BUFFALO	In cold, increase the amount of oil and jaggery in the diet of animals. In extreme cold conditions give celery and jaggery to the animals.
