Weather Forecast of District NAINITAL (Uttarakhand) Issued On: 2024-07-23 (Valid Till 08:30 IST of the next 5 days)

Weather Summary/ Alert:

The upcoming week predicts light to moderate rainfall of 20-45 mm and maximum-minimum temperature varying between 21.0-23.0oC and 16.0-17.0oC, respectively. The wind is expected to blow from south-east at a speed of 5-7 kmph. Light to moderate rainfall is likely to occur at most places on 23 July and at many on 24 to 27 July. A red alert regarding heavy to very heavy rainfall/thunderstorm accompanied with lightning / intense to very intense rain spell is likely to occur at isolated places in Nainital on 23 July. A yellow alert regarding thunderstorm accompanied with lightening/Intense rain spell is likely to occur at isolated places from 24 to 27July.

General Advisory:

For regular updates on weather conditions in the region, the farmers can get updates from the app "Meghdoot" and lightning update from the app "Damini" available on Google Play Store (Android users) and App Centre (iOS users). The NDVI shows good agricultural vigour in the isolated regions of the state ranging 0.15-0.40. The extended range forecast shows deficient rainfall, above normal maximum and normal minimum temperature trend during 19.07.2024 to 25.07.2024.

SMS Advisory:

As per IMD forecast, proper drainage channels should be maintained in the crop fields and all the farming activities should be scheduled accordingly.

Crop Specific Advisory:

Crop (Varieties)	Stage	Crop Specific Advisory
Rice	Transplanting	The transplanting should be completed in this month and gap filling of the plots should be done within 10 days. Any kind of weedicide application should be done keeping the forecast in mind.
Maize	Germination	As per the forecast, proper drainage should be arranged in the already sown field and irrigation should be avoided in the June month sown crop.

Soyabean	a 111 1	The sowing should be scheduled as per the forecast and proper drainage should be provided to avoid water stagnation.
Green gram	Sowing	The sowing should be scheduled as per the forecast.

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

Horticulture (Varieties)	Stage	Horticulture Specific Advisory
Tomato/Capsicum/ Brinjal	Harvesting	Harvesting should be done of the ripened tomato/capsicum/brinjal and proper drainage should be maintained.
Cauliflower	Transplanting	If seedlings are ready for transplanting then transplantation should be taken up keeping the forecast in mind. Short duration varieties of cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli and knol-khol can be taken up in the mid hilly regions but only after sufficient moisture in the field. Proper drainage measures should be taken as per the forecasted rainfall.
Chilli/ Frenchbean	Harvesting/ Physiological maturity	Proper drainage should be maintained in the field and any kind of spray should be avoided.

LiveStock SpecificAdvisory

Livestock	LiveStock Specific Advisory
Cow/ Buffalo	July & August month is highly favourable for cattles' delivery. So, it is recommended that their dwelling place should be clean and hygienic. Just after delivery, tie the navel of new born baby of cattle by cutting it with sharp and clean knife, then apply Gentian violet paint or tincture iodine. After animal's delivery, Gynotone or Utrotone medicine @ 200ml should be given in morning and evening hours for three days to clean the womb.
