Forecast Summary:

The upcoming week predicts no rainfall with maximum-minimum temperature varying as 19.0-20.0oC and 9.0-10.0oC, respectively. The wind is expected to blow from north-west-north, north-north-west, north-west and north-west-west direction at a speed of 2-3 kmph. No warning has been issued for the upcoming week and dry weather is expected to remain in the upcoming week.

All the apps can be easily downloaded from Google Play Store (Android users) and App Centre (iOS users). The extended range forecast shows dry pattern for rainfall, normal maximum and below normal minimum temperature trend during 07.11.2025 to 13.11.2025.

SMS Advisory:

As per IMD, no warning has been issued so the rabi sowing should be done well in time.

MUSTARD (Sowing)	In lower hills, under rainfed conditions, the sowing of the crop should be completed.
