Activities of the Department

- 1. Two M.O.U. have been done among Village Women Cluster, Gram Pradhan, Directorate of Extension Education, Department of Human Development and Family Studies, College of Home Science and Comptroller. One is at Netanagar village, Gadarpur Block, Udham Singh Nagar and another at Hartolla village, Ramgarh Block, Nainital. Training centers have been developed in both the villages where various types of trainings are provided to the villagers time to time.
- 2. Five days package of training on skill building for Child Care and education to Child Care workers are being provided time to time with the financial assistance from the Directorate of Extension Education. This training had both theory and field exposure and training. It is expected that such trained male and female trainees can work in anganwardis and Child Care day care centers in future.

3. In addition in the department, under Field Work-II course student are being trained for the five field models runs through Women Self Help Groups including early childhood care and education centre, Children Recreational Centre, Sri Sathya Sai Centre for otherwise abled children, Science Club & Eshwaramma Mother's Library. These five field models can be further replicated in the villages. 4. The department had started extension education programme since 1996-97 including training parents on childcare and health & nutrition education in Farm labour Colonies and later in nearby villages of Kiccha including Anandpur, Raghav Nagar, Narayanpur, Pratappur and Gangapur and in Gadarpur block including Kalinagar, Udaynagar, Chitranganpur, Jagdishpur, Srirampur and Rambagh.

- 5. The department continuously engaged in helping anganwadis for low cost play materials, village level children's programmes, organization and management of Self Help Groups and training from NABARD and also Collaboration with NGOs like Doeceans Society, Impart Kichha, Kumaun Sewa Samiti, Indirpur, Gayatri Swayam Sevi Santhan, Pantnagar, PEHAL Haldwani, SOS villages Bhimtal, Anugrah, New Delhi and World Vision Bhimtal have been done.
- 6. The department is running a nursery school for the children of 2 1/2 years to 3 1/2 years of age. This is a laboratory school where the students of BSc. Home Science programme organize the activities in the school.
- 7. Department is also running a Day Care Centre for the children from 6 months to 6 years of age. Here the child care along with the educational play way activities is provided to the children of working parents. This is a self financed centre.
