REGULATIONS FOR PROF. GAJENDRA SINGH ALL ROUND BEST STUDENT AWARD

- 1. At the end of IIIrd year a scholarship to be named as "Prof Gajendra Singh Award" shall be awarded to the all-round best student of the College of Technology on the basis of the composite index for academic as well as co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. Anybody who completes his/her IIIrd year of any branch of engineering shall be considered for the Prof Gajendra Singh Award.
 - At the end of IIIrd year the Secretary 4A, Pantnagar, GBPUAT, Pantnagar will notify that all the students desirous for being considered for the Prof Gajendra Singh Award should submit their candidature along with all supporting documents.
- 2. The student who fulfils the following requirements shall be eligible for being considered for the award:
 - (a) That he/she should have obtained a cumulative grade point average of 7.500 or above out of 10.000 at the end of the third year of the degree programme.
 - (b) (i) That he/she should not have been on "Academic Probation" at any time during his/her stay at this University.
 - (ii) He/she should not have been awarded any punishment under Clause 47 of the Regulations on Continuance of Studies.
 - (c) That he/she should have actively participated in at least one extra-curricular/co-curricular activity and should have secured at least fifty percent marks, out of a total 25 in co-curricular/extra-curricular activities.
- 3. The students who are eligible for this award on the basis of the criteria laid down in the clause 2 above shall be evaluated by awarding marks as follows:

(a)For academic performance	75 marks
(b) For performance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities excluding work programme, N.S.S. and N.C.C.	25 marks

- 4. The marks for academic performance shall be calculated by multiplying the CGPA by 7.5. For example, if a student obtained an OGPA of 7.500 out of 10.000 the percentage of marks for the purpose will be $7.500 \times 7.5 = 56.25$.
- 5. The marks for performance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, as in clause 3(b) above, shall be awarded on the following basis:

- 6. After grading the eligible candidates for the award of the scholarship on the basis of clause (3), (4) and (5) above, a committee consisting of the Dean of the College of Technology, Dean Student Welfare, Registrar and Heads of the Departments of College of Technology shall scrutinize the proposals and finalize the recommendations.
- 7. In case of tie, the scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of intermediate (10+2) and high school marks.
- 8. The scholarship shall be awarded at the annual Alumni Meet of the university every year and shall commence from the year 2020.
- 9. The maximum amount of scholarship will be 24,000/ year or as per the interest incurred from the fixed deposit for the scholarship.
- 10. Any matter not provided for in these regulations shall be determined by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the committee.

Prof. Gajendra Singh All Round Best Student Award

Gajendra Singh, Id. No. 910, an alumnus of 1962 batch of GBPUAT, Pantnagar (the then UPAU) received B.Tech. Degree in 1966. He received MS from Rutgers University, USA in 1968 and PhD from University of California, Davis in 1973. Dr. Singh served at the Asian Institute of Technology (AIT), Thailand from 1975 to 2004 as faculty, Chairman of Agricultural & Food Engineering Division, Dean, and Vice President for Academic Affairs. He served as DDG (Engineering) of Indian Council of Agricultural Research from 1994 to 1997. He served



as the founding Vice Chancellor of Doon University, Dehradun during 2005-08.

At present Prof. Singh is working as Adjunct Faculty at Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi; Emeritus Professor at Asian Institute of Technology, Thailand; and Chair of Science Committee of "Appropriate Scale Mechanization Consortium for Sustainable Intensification in Asian and African countries".

Prof. Singh is fellow of National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, International Academy of Agricultural and Bio-systems Engineering, International Commission of Agricultural Engineering, American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers, Indian Society of Agricultural Engineers, Institution of Engineers (India), and Soil Conservation Society of India. Prof. Singh has served as a consultant to Asian Development Bank, UNDP, FAO, UNIDO, IFPRI, UN-ESCAP, European Union, ICRISAT and IRRI.

Prof. Singh has been awarded: 1990 Kishida International Award by ASAE; 1991 Emil Mrak International Award by University of California, Davis; 1994-95 Gold Medal by Indian Society of Agricultural Engineers; 2006 Massey Ferguson Educational Gold Medal Award by ASABE; and 2009 Eminent Engineer Award by Institution of Engineers (India). He served as the Founding President of Asian Association for Agricultural Engineering, 1990-95. He has served on the Board of Trustees of the ASAE and Executive Board of International Commission of Agricultural Engineering. He served as President of the Indian Society of Agricultural Engineers for 2010-12 and its Patron since 2015.

Prof. Singh has more than 200 publications to his credit and has served on the editorial board of seven journals. He has supervised more than 90 doctoral and masters' students from all over Asia. Prof Singh has lived and worked in Thailand, India, USA and Malaysia and has traveled to more than 35 countries.
