

Pantnagar University Capable of Meeting Farmers' Seed Requirements: Dr. Kashyap

Pantnagar, June 3, 2026. At a meeting of the State Farmers' Commission, Dr. Shivendra Kumar Kashyap, Vice-Chancellor of Govind Ballabh Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, emphasized the importance of ensuring the availability of high-quality seeds for farmers across the state.
