Free Health Check-up Camp organized for Women's Health Awareness

Pantnagar, April 9, 2026. A free health check-up camp was successfully organized by the Ladies Club, Pantnagar at Lambert Square Guest House of Govind Ballabh Pant University of Agriculture and Technology, Pantnagar. The primary objective of the camp was to conduct health check-ups of women employees of the university and to raise awareness about the prevention of various diseases.

The program was organized under the leadership of Smt. Veena Chauhan, President of the Ladies Club, Pantnagar. During the camp, Senior Medical Officer Dr. Durgesh Yadav from the University Hospital, along with his team comprising four experienced doctors and two nursing staff, provided their services.

During the camp, women underwent free tests including blood pressure, eye examination, dental check-up, women's health check-up, and general health examination. A total of 60 women were examined, including 45 women workers from the University Farm and Garden Section and 15 women from various faculties.

Along with the check-ups, doctors also educated women about adopting a healthy lifestyle, maintaining a balanced diet, and the importance of regular health check-ups. They also provided detailed information on preventive measures for common diseases. On this occasion, gifts were also distributed to the women by the President of the Ladies Club, Pantnagar Smt. Veena Chauhan and the Secretary, Smt. Vijaya Singh. This initiative was highly appreciated by the women employees of the university, who expressed their expectation for regular organize of such health-related programs in the future.
