The center houses a state-of-the-art honey processing plant with a capacity of 1,000 kg per day, along with essential accessories to support hygienic and efficient honey production. The initiative aims to increase public awareness about pollinators and their significance, while also attracting interest from researchers, policymakers, and practitioners. This center stands as a model for scientific beekeeping, pollinator conservation, and rural empowerment, supporting Uttarakhand's leadership in sustainable apiculture.

This center is emerging as a reliable platform for beekeepers from Uttarakhand and beyond, offering scientific solutions and technological advancements to address their practical challenges.
